





NATIONAL COMMITTEE ORGANIZES CELEBRATION OF THE THIRD INTERNATIONAL DAY OF LIGHT IN SERBIA

May 29 and 30, 2020



After the extremely successful organization of the International Year of the Light and Light Technologies in 2015, and activities organized in 147 countries, and among them were prominent several activities and programs in Serbia, UNESCO proclaimed the International Day of Light, which will be celebrated each year.

With the proclamation at the 39th session of the General Conference of UNESCO from November 7 to 22, 2017, the first International Day of Light was held on May 16, 2018.

May 16 was chosen to mark the anniversary of the first emission of a laser beam using a ruby crystal in 1960. Lasers have transformed society through healthcare and the Internet, and laser science has been internationally recognized in over 20 Nobel Prizes.

However, International Day of Light is not only dedicated to the research and application of light in science. The purpose of the International Day of Light is to provide an annual focus on light and respect for its role in the lives of citizens of the world in the fields of science, medicine, communication and energy, as well as in the spheres of culture, education and sustainable development. The diverse theme of light will enable many different sectors of society around the world to participate in activities to raise awareness of science and technology, art and culture in this area.

During the first two years, in addition to the official celebration held at the National Library of Serbia in Belgrade, organized by the MDS National Coordination Committee, over 10,000 light lovers aged 7 to 77 had the opportunity to participate in organized activities throughout Serbia.

The competition is open to various forms of works from visual art and projects that use new media for artistic expression such as works of art, photography, cinematography, comics, digital art, lighting and music performance (installations, projections, light painting ...). Instructions for participants

Each participant can submit several papers from different disciplines. All works* will be published during the official celebration of the third International Day of Light in Serbia on May 29 and 30, 2020 on MDS social networks. The selection of the best works will be entrusted to an expert commission, and the winners of the competition will be awarded with domestic and foreign books and magazines in the field of light within the MDS2020 partner. The results of the competition will be published after June 20, 2020. The awarded participants will be notified by e-mail.

* The selection committee will not consider one piece of work that does not meet the stated restrictions for giving calls. Works with offensive or inappropriate content will be initially disqualified.


